Help for Parents to Navigate & Support Remote Learning



We are all navigating a lot right now. While we cannot escape the many complexities of this current situation, we can try our best to KISS -- keep it super simple.

To that end, here is our best, streamlined, prioritized advice for supporting remote learning:

- ☐ Make and stick to a simple schedule. Children benefit from structure, predictability, and routine.
- ☐ Check <u>ClassDojo</u> for announcements from your child's teacher and other Powel staff.
- ☐ Use Google Classroom to access remote learning assignments and links to "live" Google Meet sessions.
- ☐ Reach out if you have questions or need help. We are all in this together.

Teaching & Learning

We are now in Phase IV of the District's Remote Learning Plan. Many families are wondering what is required at this time - and what "counts" for those requirements. The chart below provides a high level summary of Phase IV requirements and how to meet them.

Attendance = Participation

Attendance is determined by <u>participation</u> in remote learning. Participation on Google Classroom can be:

- answering a check in question in the stream
- joining GoogleMeet "live" lessons
- completing assignments on time

Note: Any combination of the above will "count" for attendance; if students are unable to participate in one way, they can participate in another.

Graded Work & Activities (Required)

- Literacy/ELA: 2 assignments every week
- Math: 2 assignments every week
- Science: 1 assignment every other week
- Social Studies: 1 assignment every other week
- Health/PE: 1 assignment every other week
- Music: 1 assignment every other week

Note: For students with IEPs, completing work assigned by T.Tara or T.Sontag will "count" for their weekly graded assignments in ELA and/or Math (depending on the content of individual assignments). These students do not need to complete classroom assignments on top of individualized work.
